About the University of Aizu Community Space Kiyare

The University of Aizu Community Space *Kiyare* is an exchange space open not only to students, faculty, and staff of the University, but also to local residents.

The facility can also be used by students, faculty, and staff for educational and research activities, exhibitions and presentations (excluding music and dance recitals, etc.), and other events and activities.

Users can encounter traditional local culture and feel the warmth of nature through the interior decor, which makes use of local Aizu cotton and includes Aizu lacquer and even a tabletop made from reused wood from the Tokyo Olympic and Paralympic Athlete Village. Feel free to stop by and use *Kiyare*.

*"*Kiyare*" means "come on by" in the old dialect of the Minamiaizu region.

1. Location:

Student Hall 1st floor

2. Users:

Students, faculty, and staff of the University of Aizu, and visitors *Permission from the Director of the General Affairs and Budget Division of the Administrative Office is required to rent the facility. It may also be rented to outside parties within the scope permitted.

Weekends, national holidays*, Year's End, and New Year holidays (December 29 to January 3)

*This does not apply to events such as Open Campus or the School Festival, or when the Director of the General Affairs and Budget Division grants permission to rent the facility.

*As stipulated in the National Holidays Act

- 5. Using the Facility
 - (1) Students, faculty, and staff are free to use the facility when it is open.
 - (2) Like the university cafeteria, Kiyare is open to the community as a public good.
 - (3) If students, faculty, staff, or others wish to use the facility for purposes such as educational or research activities, they must submit a designated form and obtain permission from the Director of the General Affairs and Budget Division of the Administrative Office.
- 6. Notes on Use
 - (1) Please carefully read and comply with the User Rules for the University of Aizu Community Space *Kiyare*.
 - (2) Do not leave personal belongings in the facility.

- (3) Do not drink alcoholic beverages or smoke.
- (4) Clean your tables and return your chairs to their original position.
- (5) Do not damage interior decor or other items in the facility.
- (6) If you have any questions, contact the General Affairs and Budget Section of the Administrative Office. Misuse of the facility or failure to follow the instructions of the staff may result in measures such as temporary or permanent suspension of use of the facility.
