

# Environmental Policies of the Public University Corporation, the University of Aizu

## 1. Fundamental Missions

The Public University Corporation, the University of Aizu is aiming to create a unique university towards the sustainable development, utilizing its features as a public university corporation, and its founding mission, "To Advance Knowledge for Humanity" through pursuits involving inventions and discoveries to contribute to the peace and prosperity of humanity. Regarding the Junior College Division, students will be provided with opportunities to learn practical knowledge and skills closely related to culture and features of the Aizu area.

In modern society, the global environment has drastically changed through global warming, for example, caused by current lifestyles based on large-scale consumption of limited natural resources and energy. This has threatened the very foundation of survival for creatures living on the planet, including humans, more seriously than ever.

At the Public University Corporation, the University of Aizu, individual faculty, administrative personnel members, and students have determined to proactively address these issues regarding environment conservation, aiming to create a sustainable recycling-oriented society where humans can coexist with nature. Accordingly, environmental policies shall be provided for herein.

## 2. Fundamental Policies (Environmental Policies)

- (1) The Public University Corporation, the University of Aizu shall determine its environmental goals based on its fundamental missions, and promote activities to minimize its burden on the environment.
- (2) All faculty and administrative personnel members shall participate in and steadily promote activities to minimize its burden on the environment.
- (3) The Public University Corporation, the University of Aizu shall increase students' awareness regarding environment conservation and encourage them to proactively participate in activities towards conservation of the environment.
- (4) The Public University Corporation, the University of Aizu shall observe relevant laws, etc. and make continuous efforts to improve an environment management system in order to further reduce its burden on the environment.
- (5) The Public University Corporation, the University of Aizu shall make these environmental policies broadly known to the general public, including students, as well as all faculty and administrative personnel members.
