

UNIVERSITY REGULATION ON THE UNIVERSITY OF AIZU PUBLIC  
RELATIONS AND WEBSITE COMMITTEE

Article One  
(Objective)

1.1 This regulation - based upon the provisions of Article 30 of the University Regulation Concerning the Internal Administrative Organization and Other Aspects of the University of Aizu (for the purpose of this regulation, hereinafter referred to as "ADMINISTRATIVE ORGANIZATION REGULATION")-provides for the method of administration and other necessary matters of the Public Relations and Website Committee (for the purpose of this regulation, hereinafter referred to as "COMMITTEE").

Article Two  
(Matters for Deliberation)

2.1 The matters for deliberation of the COMMITTEE shall be as follows:

- (1) Matters concerning University public relations;
- (2) Matters concerning strategies for public relations, operational management, recommendations for implementation, etc.;
- (3) Other matters concerning public relations and publications at the University.

Article Three  
(Organization)

3.1 The COMMITTEE shall be organized of the following individuals, the University President shall serve as the COMMITTEE Chairperson, and a member designated by the COMMITTEE Chairperson serving as the COMMITTEE Vice Chairperson:

- (1) University President
- (2) University Vice President
- (3) Dean of the Graduate School
- (4) Director General of the Administrative Office
- (5) Dean of the Undergraduate School
- (6) Director of the Information Systems and Technology Center
- (7) Director General of the Department for Student Affairs

Article Four  
(Term of Office)

4.1 The term of office of COMMITTEE members shall be two years; members can be reappointed. However, the term of office of those members initially selected to fill a vacancy shall be the remainder of the vacated term.

Article Five

(Meetings)

5.1 The COMMITTEE Chairperson shall convoke meetings and serve as the chair thereof.

5.2 The COMMITTEE, if for which more than half of the members belonging thereto are not present, may not be convened.

5.3 Matters before the COMMITTEE requiring a decision shall be decided by more than half of those members in attendance; and when there is an equal number of members supporting both sides of an issue, the chair of the COMMITTEE meeting shall render the decision.

Article Six

(Attendance by Related Individuals)

6.1 The COMMITTEE Chairperson, when he/she recognizes doing so as necessary, may require the attendance of related nonmembers for the purpose of requesting explanations from such nonmembers and having them provide opinions.

Article Seven

(Working Group)

7.1 This COMMITTEE shall establish a working group as necessary in order to conduct specialized investigations on the matters provided for in Article 2 herein.

7.2 The Working Group shall be organized of members appointed by the COMMITTEE Chairperson.

Article Eight

(Miscellaneous Affairs)

8.1 Miscellaneous affairs concerning the COMMITTEE shall be performed by the Planning and Collaboration Division of the Administrative Office, and practical business affairs concerning daily duties, inquiries, etc. shall be performed by the administrative office of the COMMITTEE determined separately.

Article Nine

(Supplemental Provisions)

9.1 Other than provided for by this regulation, necessary matters concerning the administration of the COMMITTEE shall be determined separately by the Committee Chairperson by way of consultation with the COMMITTEE.

ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS

This regulation shall be enforced as of April 1, 2006.

This regulation shall be enforced as of April 1, 2009.

This regulation shall be enforced as of March 4, 2013.
