

UNIVERSITY REGULATION ON THE UNIVERSITY OF AIZU COMMUNITY
AFFAIRS PLANNING COMMITTEE

Article One
(Objective)

1.1 This regulation-based upon the provisions of Article 30 of the University Regulation Concerning The Internal Administrative Organization And Other Aspects Of The University Of Aizu (for the purpose of this regulation, hereinafter referred to as "ADMINISTRATIVE ORGANIZATION REGULATION")-provides for the method of administration and other necessary matters of the Community Affairs Planning Committee (for the purpose of this regulation, hereinafter referred to as "COMMITTEE").

Article Two
(Matters For Deliberation)

2.1 The COMMITTEE shall deliberate the following matters:

- (1) Matters concerning the planning and administration of public lectures; and
- (2) Other matters concerning University public access activities.

Article Three
(Organization)

3.1 The COMMITTEE shall be organized of the members listed below.

- (1) One member selected each from the academic department and the graduate departments
- (2) One member selected each from the Research Center for Advanced Information Science and Technology, the Center for Language Research, and the Center for Cultural Research and Studies
- (3) Members designated by the University President

Article Four
(Term Of Office)

4.1 The term of office of COMMITTEE members shall be two years; members can be reappointed. However, the term of office of those members initially selected to fill a vacancy shall be the remainder of the vacated term.

Article Five
(COMMITTEE Chairperson)

5.1 The position of COMMITTEE Chairperson shall be established within the COMMITTEE and a member designated by the University President shall serve as the COMMITTEE Chairperson.

Article Six
(Chairperson of Meetings)

6.1 The COMMITTEE Chairperson shall convoke COMMITTEE meetings and serve as the chair thereof.

Article Seven
(Meetings)

7.1 The COMMITTEE, if for which more than half of the members belonging thereto are not present, may not be convened.

7.2 Matters requiring a decision by the COMMITTEE shall be decided by more than half of those members in attendance; and when there is an equal number of members supporting both sides of an issue, the chair of the committee meeting shall render the decision.

Article Eight
(Attendance By Related Individuals)

8.1 The Committee Chairperson, when he/she recognizes doing so as necessary, may require the attendance of related nonmembers at a COMMITTEE meeting for the purpose of requesting explanations from such nonmembers and having them provide opinions.

Article Nine
(Miscellaneous Affairs)

9.1 Miscellaneous affairs concerning the COMMITTEE shall be performed by the Planning and Collaboration Division of the Administrative Office.

Article Ten
(Supplemental Provisions)

10.1 Other than provided for in this regulation, necessary matters concerning the administration of the COMMITTEE shall be determined separately by the COMMITTEE Chairperson by way of consultation with the COMMITTEE.

ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS

This regulation shall be enforced as of April 1, 2006.

ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS

This regulation shall be enforced as of April 1, 2008.

ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS

This regulation shall be enforced as of May 20, 2009.

ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS

This regulation shall be enforced as of March 4, 2013.
