

UNIVERSITY REGULATION ON THE UNIVERSITY OF AIZU FACULTY COMMITTEE
ON STUDENT CAREER DEVELOPMENT

(Regulation No. 19, April 1, 2006)

Article One

(Objective)

1.1 This regulation—based upon the provisions of Article 29 of the University Regulation Concerning The Internal Administrative Organization And Other Aspects Of The University Of Aizu provides for the method of administration and other necessary matters of the Faculty Committee on Student Career Development (for the purpose of this regulation, hereinafter referred to as "COMMITTEE").

Article Two

(Matters For Deliberation)

2.1 The matters for deliberation of the COMMITTEE shall be as follows:

- (1)Matters concerning provision of information and advice pertaining to career development;
- (2)Matters concerning student career development activities;
- (3)Matters concerning the collection, regulation, and inquiries of career development materials; and
- (4)Other necessary matters concerning student career development.

Article Three

(Organization)

3.1 The COMMITTEE shall be organized of the following members:

- (1)The Director General of the Department for Student Affairs; and
- (2)Up to five members appointed by The University President.

Article Four

(Term Of Office)

4.1 The term of office of those members provided for in Paragraph 3.1, Item 2 and 3 above shall be tow years; these members can be reappointed. However, the term of office of those members initially selected to fill a vacancy shall be the remainder of the vacated term.

Article Five
(Committee Chairperson)

5.1 The position of Committee Chairperson shall be established within the COMMITTEE and shall be served by the Director General of the Department for Student Affairs.

Article Six
(Meetings)

6.1 The Committee Chairperson shall convoke the COMMITTEE meeting and serve as the chair thereof.

6.2 The COMMITTEE, if for which more than half of the members belonging thereto are not present, may not be convened.

6.3 Matters before the COMMITTEE requiring a decision shall be decided by more than half of those members in attendance; and when there is an equal number of members supporting both sides of an issue, the chair of the committee meeting shall render the decision.

Article Seven
(Attendance By Related Individuals)

7.1 The Committee Chairperson, when he/she recognizes doing so as necessary, may require the attendance of related nonmembers for the purpose of requesting explanations from such nonmembers and having them provide opinions.

Article Eight
(Miscellaneous Affairs)

8.1 Miscellaneous affairs concerning the COMMITTEE shall be performed by the Student Affairs Division of the Administrative Office.

Article Nine
(Supplemental Provisions)

9.1 Other than provided for by this regulation, necessary matters concerning the administration of the COMMITTEE shall be determined separately by the Committee Chairperson by way of consultation with the COMMITTEE.

ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS

This regulation shall be enforced as of April 1, 2006.

This regulation shall be enforced as of April 1, 2008.

This regulation shall be enforced as of May 20, 2009.

This regulation shall be enforced as of April 1, 2019.
