

UNIVERSITY REGULATION ON THE UNIVERSITY OF AIZU INFORMATION
SYSTEMS AND TECHNOLOGY CENTER

Article One

(Objective)

1.1 This regulation –based upon the provisions of Article 6 of Basic Regulation Concerning the Organization and Business Operation of the Public University Corporation, the University of Aizu –provides for necessary matters related to the internalorg– anization, management, and administration of the University of Aizu Information Systems and Technology Center (for the purpose of this regulation, hereinafter referred to as “CENTER”).

Article Two

(Purpose)

2.1 The purpose of the CENTER shall be to contribute to the advancement of education and reseach at the University Of Aizu by supplying and effectively applying and offering the information related environment necessary for education and research activities.

Article Three

(Internal Organization)

3.1 The CENTER shall be composed of the Information Processing Center and the University Library.

3.2 The University Library shall include the Resource Lounges.

Article Four

(Operations)

4.1 The CENTER shall perform the following operations for the purpose of accompli– shing the purpose provided in Article 2 herein.

(1) The collection, storage, processing, and offering of information related to education and research;

(2) The supply, management, and administration of systems related to information and communication;

- (3) The supporting of education activities that apply teaching materials and multimedia environments;
- (4) The supporting of research activities;
- (5) The communication with outside entities;
- (6) Operations provided for under the provisions of the University Regulation On The Use Of The Information Processing Center (Information Systems And Technology Center)
- (7) The collection, arrangement, and preservation of the library materials;
- (8) Any other operations provided for under the provisions of the University Regulation On The Use Of The University Library (Information Systems And Technology Center).
- (9) The offering of academic information necessary for education and research; and
- (10) Other operations necessary to accomplish the purpose for which the CENTER is established.

Article Five
(Advisory Board)

5.1 In order to smoothly carry out the work provided for in items (1) to (6) of the preceding article, an advisory board which will provide technical advice as needed shall be established.

5.2 The advisory board shall be comprised of full-time faculty members of the University and other individuals outside the university with expertise in relevant fields who have been designated by the CENTER Director and approved by the University President. The term of office of those members shall be one year, however the members can be reappointed.

ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS

This regulation shall be enforced as of April 1, 2006.

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This regulation shall be enforced as of April 1, 2009.

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This regulation shall be enforced as of April 1, 2016.
