

University Regulation on the University of Aizu Revitalization Center Steering Committee

(Regulation No.2, March 4, 2013)

Article One

(Objective)

1.1 This regulation, based on the provisions in Article 30 of the University Regulation Concerning the Internal Administrative Organization and Other Aspects of The University Of Aizu(Regulation No. 10, enforced as of April 1, 2006), provides for the method of management and other necessary matters of the University of Aizu Revitalization Center Steering Committee (hereinafter referred to as "COMMITTEE").

Article Two

(Matters for Deliberation)

2.1 The COMMITTEE shall deliberate on the following matters.

- (1) Matters related to the management and operation of the University of Aizu Revitalization Center (hereinafter referred to as "CENTER");
- (2) Matters related to the establishment, revision, or repeal of regulations concerning the CENTER;
- (3) Matters related to the CENTER's revitalization support activities/programs; and
- (4) Matters related to the CENTER in general.

Article Three

(Organization)

3.1 The COMMITTEE shall be composed of at most twenty-five members recommended by the University President or a Division Head. The COMMITTEE Chairperson, depending on necessity, may request attendance by learned individuals inside or outside the University of Aizu.

Article Four

(Term of Office)

4.1 The term of office of those members in Paragraph 3.1 above shall be two years. These members can be reappointed.

4.2 Notwithstanding the provisions of Paragraph 4.1 above, when a vacancy occurs during an existing term, that vacancy shall be filled promptly by a replacement to serve the remainder of the existing term.

Article Five

(Meetings)

5.1 The CENTER Director shall convoke COMMITTEE meetings and shall serve as Chairperson thereof. Should the CENTER Director be unable to fulfill the Chairperson's duties, the Deputy CENTER Director shall perform those duties on the CENTER Director's behalf.

Article Six

(Decisions)

6.1 The quorum of COMMITTEE meetings shall be more than half of the members belonging thereto, and decisions shall be rendered by more than half of those members in attendance. When there is an equal number supporting both sides of an issue, the Chairperson shall render the decision.

Article Seven

(Miscellaneous Affairs)

7.1 Miscellaneous affairs concerning the COMMITTEE shall be supervised by the Director of the CENTER Business Office.

ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS

1. This regulation shall be enforced as of March 4, 2013.
2. Notwithstanding the provisions in Article Three herein, the initial constituents of the COMMITTEE shall be those belonging to the existing "Preparation Committee for Establishment of the University of Aizu Revitalization Center".
3. With regard to those initial constituents provided for in the preceding provision, their term of office shall be counted starting from the first day of the next fiscal year following the COMMITTEE's establishment.
